



This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, and protect the personal information you provide when you use the FilesThruTheAir™ Cloud service provided through the [www.wifisensorcloud.com](http://www.wifisensorcloud.com) website. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, capitalised terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meaning as in the Terms of Service.

If we decide to change our Privacy Policy, we will post the changes here so that you will always know what information we gather, how we might use that information, and whether we will disclose it to anyone. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy is effective from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2013.

## Information We Collect

In order to access and use the Service, you will need to register and provide us with your Customer Data which will contain information or data that can be used to contact or identify you, such as your name, address, phone number, email address and credit card details. You may also give us information about you by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you search for an Account Type, place an order on our site, [participate in discussion boards or other social media functions on our site], or any other activity commonly carried out on the site and when you report a problem with our site.

With regard to each of your visits to our site we may automatically collect the following information:

- technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, your login information, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform;
- information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL) clickstream to, through and from our site (including date and time); products you viewed or searched for; page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page and any phone number used to call our customer service number.

We use and disclose your Customer Data only as follows:

- To analyse usage and improve the Service.
- To deliver to you any administrative notices, alerts and communications regarding the Service.
- To fulfill your requests for certain products and services.
- For our own market research and project planning.



- To troubleshoot problems, detect and protect against errors, fraud or other criminal activity.
- To third-party contractors that provide services for us and who are bound by these same privacy restrictions.
- To enforce the Terms of Service.
- To notify you of any changes to this Privacy Policy, the Terms of Service or the Refund Policy.
- As otherwise outlined in this Privacy Policy.

We also ask that you provide us with your Customer Data to allow us to access your Account Type. We use your Customer Data to access your accounts in order to provide you the Service. By providing us with your Account Information, you acknowledge and agree that we may access, retrieve and store your Customer Data in order to make such Customer Data available and viewable through the Service.

From time to time we may request other Customer Data to provide you with other benefits of the Service. In all such instances, you will be given the opportunity to provide or to decline to provide that information, and it will be used for the stated purpose and/or in accordance with our then-current Privacy Policy.

## Use of Your Information

We use the information that we collect from you to provide the Service. In addition to this we may use the information for one or more of the following purposes:

- To provide information to you that you request from us relating to our products or services.
- To provide information to you relating to other products that may be of interest to you. Such additional information will only be provided where you have consented to receive such information.
- To inform you of any changes to our website, services or goods and products.

If you have previously purchased goods or services from us we may provide to you details of similar goods or services, or other goods and services, that you may be interested in.

## Storing Your Personal Data

In providing the Service it may become necessary to transfer data that we collect from you to locations outside of the European Union for processing and storing. By providing your personal data to us, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing.



We endeavour to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to make sure that your data is treated and stored securely. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical and electronic procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Unfortunately the sending of information via the internet is not totally secure and on occasion such information can be intercepted. We cannot guarantee the security of data that you choose to send us electronically, Sending such information is entirely at your own risk.

## Disclosing Your Information

We will not disclose your Customer Data to any other party other than in accordance with this Privacy Policy and in the circumstances detailed below:

- i. Where we are legally required by law to disclose your Customer Data.
- ii. To further fraud protection and reduce the risk of fraud.
- iii. In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
- iv. If our company or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by us about our customers will be one of the transferred assets.

## Access to Information

In accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 you have the right to access any information that we hold relating to you. Please note that any request for information must be made in writing and we reserve the right to charge a fee of £10 to cover costs incurred by us in providing you with the information.

## Cookies

Most websites (around 92% of all websites) use cookies which are small text files stored on your computer, these can then be used by websites for a variety of purposes, including login systems, storing shopping cart items, remembering preferences, tracking visitors and more.

## How do we use Cookies?

Currently the FilesThruTheAir™ Cloud uses only 'session cookies', sometimes called transient cookies. The cookie is erased when the user closes the Web browser. Session cookies do not collect information from the user's computer, and their contents do not personally identify the user.
